



## Snowbound Block Three



### APPLIQUÉ:

- Cut appliqué background square 9 1/2" x 9 1/2". (You may want to cut a bit larger and trim to size after appliqué is complete.)
- Prepare appliqué using your favorite method. Mark snowman's eyes, nose, mouth, part of arm, and button placement with a fabric pencil or water erasable marker.
- Before you applique the "Wish" banner, place the banner applique and pattern right side up over a light box or bright window. Trace the wording onto banner with a fabric pencil or water erasable marker.
- Center snowman on background fabric. Place finished bottom of snowman 3/4" up from bottom raw edge of background fabric.
- Appliqué snowman, banner, scarf, ear muffs, and stars in place following pattern. (Note: you can also use wool for the ear muffs or embroider them with a satin stitch)

### EMBROIDERY:

- Place the background and pattern right side up over a light box or bright window. Trace the rest of the snowman's arms, and snow line onto background with a fabric pencil or water erasable marker.
- Arms: Chain stitch, DMC #300 brown or dark brown of choice, 2 strands.
- Eyes & mouth: French knots, DMC #310 black, 2 strands. Wrap floss around needle 3 times.
- Nose: Outline with tiny back stitch, fill in with satin stitch, lengthwise, DMC #3776 orange, 2 strands .
- Wire headband: Tiny stem stitch, DMC #535, 2 strands.
- Wording: "Wish" Tiny back stitch, DMC #300 brown, 2 strands.
- Snow line: Tiny stem stitch, DMC blanc, 3 strands.
- Stars: DMC blanc, outline around appliqué, chain stitch, 2 strands.
- After quilting is complete sew a 1/2" red button to scarf. Sew three 1/8" black buttons to front of snowman.
