

#### 17" x 13" Pillow

Time to decorate for Christmas with our *Believe* pillow. It's easy to make and looks cute tucked on a mantle, sitting on a chair or placed among a collection of snowmen. It's a free pattern from Bunny Hill, and one I hope you enjoy making!

## Materials Needed

white fabric: 1/4 yard or 1 fat quarter

red fabric: ½ yard

red prints: 8" x 8" square of 3 different prints

white wool: 1 - 4" x 5" orange wool: 1 - 1" x 1" scrap pillow form: 11" x 16"

## Cutting

# Pillow Front:

From white fabric cut 1 -  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strip From red fabric cut 2 - 3" x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, and 2 - 3" x  $17\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

#### Pillow Back:

From red fabric cut 2 - 13½" x 11½" rectangles


## Construction Use 1/4" seam allowance.


# 1 Pillow Front

- (A) Prepare the letters for appliqué using your favorite method.
- (B) Center letters on background following color photo. Place beginning and end of *Believe 3*/4" from side raw edges of 81/2" x 121/2" background. Some of the letters have been slanted to give the pillow a more whimsical look. Appliqué the letters to the background following color photo.



(C) Sew the 2 - 3" x 8½" strips, 2 - 3" x 17½" strips and background together as shown. Press in direction of arrows.

# **S**nowman

- (A) Trace the snowman and nose pattern onto the dull side of freezer paper.
- (B) With a hot iron, press the shiny side of snowman and nose template to right side of wools. Using sharp scissors, cut out wools on line of templates. Remove freezer paper templates.
- (C) Transfer embroidery lines for eyes, mouth and buttons to wool with a water erasable marker.
- (D) Using 2 strands embroidery floss that matches wool, blanket or whip stitch snowman in place.
- (E) Trace the snowman's arms to background following pattern. Complete embroidery before you assemble pillow back.
- (F) Embroider the snowman using 2 strands of embroidery floss:

Eyes & Mouth: French knots, Cosmo #600 or DMC #310 black.

Buttons: Cross stitch, Cosmo #600 or

DMC #310 black.


Arms: Chain stitch, Comso #310 or DMC #801






# **?** Pillow Back

- (A) Turn under ¼" hem on one 13½" side of each back piece and press.
  - (B) Turn under 1/4" again and press. Top stitch hem.



# Pillow Assembly

- (A) With right sides together and raw edges matching, layer one pillow back on top of pillow front. Pin in place.
- (B) With right sides together layer second pillow back on top of pillow front and first pillow back. Pin in place.
- (C) Stitch ¼" from raw edges all the way around the pillow. Turn pillow right side out. Press. Insert pillow form.
