

SEW THE BLOCKS TOGETHER

Now that all your blocks are completed, it's time to put the quilt together. Arrange your stocking blocks and alternate blocks following the picture of the quilt and the diagram below. Sew the rows together, pressing toward the alternate blocks. Your quilt will measure $40\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ".



40½" x 40½"

BORDERS

When you have your quilt top pieced together add the borders. Please refer to Organizing the Fabric, page 1. (Released with the first Stocking Block on July 7th.)

Christmas Dot Gingerbread: (Inner border)

Cut (4) 11/2" x width of fabric strips

Cut sides: 1½" x 40½"

Cut top and bottom: 1½" x 42½"

Candy Red Snow Flakes (Outer border)

Cut (5) 4" x width of fabric strips

Cut sides 4" x 42 1/2"

Cut and piece top and bottom to measure 4" x 49½"

Candy Cane Red Stripe: (Binding)

Cut (6) strips 21/4" by width of fabric. Sew strips together end to end for binding.

INNER BORDER

- 1. Sew the 1 ½" x 40½" Gingerbread Christmas Dot strips to each side of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.
- 2. Sew the 1 ½" 42½" Gingerbread Christmas Dot Strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.

OUTER BORDER

- 1. Sew the 4" x 42½" Candy Cane Red Snow Flakes strips to each side of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.
- 2. Sew the 4" x 49½" Candy Cane Red Snow Flakes strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.


ADD APPLIQUÉ SNOWMEN AND STARS TO THE BORDER

See Pages 5-8 for appliqué and embellishment.

After appliqué and embroidery are complete, layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add embellishments and bind with Candy Cane Red Stripe.



ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

The snowmen are made using Icicle White Snow Flakes. Prepare appliqué using your preferred method. Follow color photo for other fabrics needed and cut these from your layer cake.

Place the snowmen and pattern right side up over a light box or bright window. Trace eyes, nose, mouth, arms with a fabric pencil or water erasable marker.

Arrange snowmen and stars appliqué on borders following color photo and numbers on pattern. Appliqué.

Complete embroidery.

After appliqué and embroidery are complete, layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add embellishments and bind with Candy Cane Red Stripe.

EMBROIDERY: ALL EMBROIDERY USES 2 STRANDS FLOSS

Snowman's Eyes: French knots, Cosmo #600 or DMC #310 black


Snowman's Mouth: French knots, Cosmo #600 or DMC #310 black

Snowman's Nose: Outline with a tiny back stitch, fill in with a satin stitch, Cosmo #186 or DMC #922 orange

Snowman's Arms: Stem stitch, Cosmo #577 or DMC #434 brown


EMBELLISHMENTS

After quilting is complete, sew a small ivory star button to the top of the snowmen caps, and (6) 1/4" black buttons and (3) 1/4" cardinal red hearts to the snowmen bodies.






Star Applique
