

## Country Christmas Mitered Corner Napkins


Finished dimensions: 16" x 16" Featuring *Country Christmas Stripe* #2960-11

Bring Country Christmas to your dinner table with our simple mitered corner napkins.


## MATERIAL NEEDED:

2 Dinner Napkins = ½ yard 4 Dinner Napkins = 1 yard


- \* Cut (1) square 18" x 18".
  - \* *First Fold*: Fold the four raw edges ½" toward the wrong side of the fabric. Press.
  - \* Second Fold: Fold the edges ½" toward the wrong side again. Press.




\* Unfold the corner and trace the crease with a water erasable marker or fabric pencil.




Unfold the Second Fold at one corner.
Following diagram, fold the corner into a triangle so that it's two 'legs' measure 1".
Finger press fold.




\* Fold the corner over into a point, right sides together, making sure the ends of the drawn lines meet. Pin the corner into place.



- \* Sew the two sides together along the traced line, backstitching at the beginning and end of the seam. Trim the tip of the corner off, leaving a 1/8" seam allowance. Finger press seam open.
  - \* Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the other three corners.
- \* Refold the *Second Fold*, inserting the corners into their neat mitered position as you do.
  - \* Push the tips of the corners out so they are pointy.
  - \* Press and pin down the *Second Fold*.





- \* Edge-stitch the fold around all four sides, backstitching at the beginning and end of the seam.
  - \* Your napkin is finished!
  - \* Now, repeat for all the remaining napkin squares and you have a set!
